

TOPIC : "DON'T JUDGE A BOOK BY ITS COVER"

This phrase is ascribed to a 1944 edition of the African journal, 'American Speech', which said, 'You can't judge a book by its binding'. It went on to gain more popularity in the 1946 murder mystery 'Murder in the Glass Room', which stated, 'You can never tell a book by its cover.'

Often in life, you must have heard, 'don't judge a book by its cover'. The phrase is self-explanatory and has a deep meaning behind it. It means that we must not underestimate anyone based on their looks. In fact, the deeds and characters of the person matter the most. Thus, don't judge a book by its cover essay will help us understand its meaning

Why Should We Never Judge a Book by Its Cover?

There are many reasons why we must never judge a book by its cover. This first one is that you know nothing about someone just by their outward appearance. It should never be the judge of someone's character.

For instance, if you look at a good-looking person, you can only see their skin colour, physical traits, and maybe fashion. But what about beyond that? You cannot solely make up your mind on their outward appearance.

What if the good-looking person turns out to be horrible in nature? What if they lack any real talent or skill? Thus, you see how outward appearances can be misleading. They are basically valueless things so never judge someone on their face value. It is not a good practice to judge a book by its cover, as looks can deceive others easily. Forming opinions completely based on seeing the surface is wrong. We should always know about the other person completely and then make a decision.

On the other hand, something which may not possess beautiful features may have much more value than something beautiful. In other words, the appearance of someone is not equivalent to their worth. Thus, we must judge the person on the basis of their personality and capabilities and not merely external appearance.

TOPIC : “DON’T JUDGE A BOOK BY ITS COVER”

But he went by wearing a simple saffron colour Indian clothes and an Indian turban. He went by wearing this in Chicago where more than 7000 people came. Everyone was laughing at India, that India has sent such guy for this conference. They were judging India only by looking at Swamiji’s apperance. They judged him that he don’t have any type of outer knowledge. After that, from each country, each person went and glorify their country. But now it’s a time for India, the person name called from India and he went on stage and spoke “5 words” which won the heart of 7000 people and that words were “Sisters and Brothers of America” and for 2 min 7000 people appreciated India. And the person who spoke this words were “Swami Vivekanand” by saying 5 words he showed the power of Hinduism “वसुधैव कुटुम्बकम्” which showed that everyone is our brother and sisters. And that day Swami Vivekanand had given a so much powerful speech that 7000 people clapped for 2 minutes that that is how only one Indian shook the whole world and showed the power of Sanaatan Dharma.... Like let's take one more example. One day APJ Abdul Kalam was sitting near a beach and thinking something, then a person with Srimad Bhagavad Gita in his hand came and sat near APJ Abdul Kalam. TOPIC : “DON’T JUDGE A BOOK BY ITS COVER”

Importance of the Phrase “Don’t Judge a Book by Its Cover”:

TOPIC : ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Less than a decade after helping the Allied forces win World War II by breaking the Nazi encryption machine Enigma, mathematician Alan Turing changed history a second time with a simple question: “Can machines think?”

Turing’s 1950 paper “Computing Machinery and Intelligence” and its subsequent Turing Test established the fundamental goal and vision of AI.

So, what is actually AI?

While addressing a crowd at the Japan AI Experience in 2017, Data Robot CEO Jeremy Achin began his speech by offering the following definition of how AI is used today:

“AI is a computer system able to perform tasks that ordinarily require human intelligence ... Many of these artificial intelligence systems are powered by machine learning, some of them are powered by deep learning and some of them are powered by very boring things like rules.”

The major limitation in defining AI as simply “building machines that are intelligent” is that it doesn't actually explain what AI is and what makes a machine intelligent. AI is an interdisciplinary science with multiple approaches, but advancements in machine learning and deep learning are creating a paradigm shift in virtually every sector of the tech industry.

Meanwhile, in their book Artificial Intelligence: A Modern Approach, authors Stuart Russell and Peter Norvig approach the concept of AI by unifying their work around the theme of intelligent agents in machines. With this in mind, AI is “the study of agents that receive percepts from the environment and perform actions.”

If we focus on what's possible today with AI, here are some of the potential negative impacts of artificial intelligence that we should consider and plan for:

Change the jobs humans do/job automation: AI will change the workplace and the jobs that humans do. Some jobs will be lost to AI technology, so humans will need to embrace the change and find new activities that will provide them the social and mental benefits their job provided.

Political, legal, and social ramifications: As Bostrom advises, rather than avoid pursuing AI innovation, "Our focus should be on putting ourselves in the best possible position so that when all the pieces fall into place, we've done our homework. We've developed scalable AI control methods, we've thought hard about the ethics and the governments, etc. And then proceed further and then hopefully have an extremely good outcome from that." If our governments and business institutions don't spend time now formulating rules, regulations, and responsibilities, there could be significant negative ramifications as AI continues to mature.

Social manipulation and AI bias: So far, AI is still at risk for being biased by the humans that build it. If there is bias in the data sets the AI is trained from, that bias will affect AI action. In the wrong hands, AI can be used, as it was in the 2016 U.S. presidential election, for social manipulation and to amplify misinformation.

TEACHER'S CORNER

How far the word "Teacher" has been replaced by a "Mentor"

The key difference between the two roles, mentor and teacher, stems from the focus of the individual roles. When it comes to education, knowledge, and guidance, we rely on a number of individuals such as teachers, mentors, educators, coaches, and tutors. Each of these individuals play a unique role in the life of the student. First let us define these two words mentor and teacher. A teacher is an individual who is engaged in imparting knowledge to the students. A mentor, however, is a bit different from a teacher. A mentor is an experienced person who acts as an advisor to another individual.

Most of us know what teachers do. Like many others, I've had teachers throughout grade school, high school, and college. Mentors didn't come until later on when I decided to venture into entrepreneurship, and they have immensely helped me bring clarity to the otherwise chaotic world of building a business.

Teachers are extremely important. But teachers and mentors fulfill different roles when it comes to personal growth. Mistaking one for the other isn't entirely helpful for those seeking out different forms of guidance.

Three differences between a teacher and mentor

1. Mentorship is based on building a relationship between mentor and mentee

- Mentorship is a two-way street. As the mentor instructs the mentee, a closer bond forms between both of them. This relationship is fundamental behind every great mentorship. If this relationship doesn't exist, the mentee will be less likely to follow the mentor's guidance or even trust what they have to say.

2. A mentor guides you. A teacher teaches.

- Mentorships are based on a mentor's effective guidance of the mentee's growth, whether professional or personal. As such, this is hard to quantify and is largely based on how the mentee decides to proceed following the mentor's advice. On the other hand, a teacher instructs you on a subject matter based on a set of predefined criteria. Most of the time, the main goal of a teacher is to make sure that their students get great grades.

3. Mentorship is more holistic, complex and based on fulfilling a vision

- Finally, mentorship isn't measured quantitatively in the same way that teaching is. But this does not make it any less effective. As mentorship is based on guidance, a mentor can also help their mentee on more complex social situations, such as getting promoted, founding a company, or switching careers.
