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Dear Parents and Learners,

While most CBSE schools have already started their academic session, parents are finally coming to terms with a fresh challenge – the new assessment pattern implemented by the board. The board has abolished the continuous and comprehensive evaluation (CCE) pattern and brought back the earlier pattern of assessment with emphasis on pen-paper tests.

Question is that why CBSE has re-introduced such pattern of evaluation?

To give this answer we need to understand the cause behind the same. As per the survey only 2% schools in India were correctly assessing (CCE) the students as per their capabilities and hard work. The students were moving from one grade to another without putting their efforts and same was with the faculties. The home board condition was even worst. Students were getting the certificates and did really not know the basic concepts. Parents were not worried and gap between both was increasing.

So, the step taken by CBSE is really needs a warm welcome in current era.

As per that, the board hasn't restricted any school from taking additional tests or undertaking class projects. So at our school, we have left it to Subject teacher to decide if she wants to conduct additional class tests. Teachers can carry with all those activities whatever doing previously for the assessment if feel really effective, for the development of a child either in personality basis or in academics. At this time, a student has to learn the concept deeply on the regular basis. It means the efforts must be a continuous process and have to come up with the positive vibration.

The parents should act as a bridge between the school and the child.

For this, students really need not take any stress, but at the same time they should work on time and confusions must be cleared immediately. They have to be regular and punctual. As per the new pattern if a learner is really working on the right concept, he or she doesn't need any external support and thus the Quality of Education will definitely improve.

अनुशासन में रहने वाले विद्यार्थी सर्वत्र परीक्षी होते हैं। उनमें टालमटोल की प्रवृत्ति नहीं होती तथा वे आज के कार्य कल पर नहीं छोड़ते हैं। उनके यही गुण धीरे-धीरे उन्हें सम्मान्य विद्यार्थियों से एक अलग पहचान दिलाते हैं।
